This conference follows the First International Conference on Inner City Health, which was held in Toronto, Canada on October 3-6, 2002. This first conference emphasized the health of disadvantaged inner-city populations. The Second International Conference on Urban Health broadened this focus and considered urban health as an emerging multi-disciplinary area of study.

The Second International Conference on Urban Health coincided with the formation of the International Society for Urban Health (ISUH), whose goal is to facilitate the exchange of perspectives, research methods, and data on the study of health in urban areas and the effects of urbanization on health. ISUH also will evaluate and help develop programs that lessen health risks and promote well-being for people living in urban areas.
